FOR LOW-INCOME HOMEOWNERS

Does your home need “A BRUSH WITH KINDNESS”

Northern Ocean Habitat for Humanity launched the program A Brush With Kindness, to provide exterior home repairs to qualifying low-income homeowners. Repairs include, but are not limited to, painting, landscaping and other minor repairs.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Interested homeowners must be able to demonstrate:

- Proof of ownership and residency in the Northern Ocean Habitat region
- Financial need. This program is for low income households.

HOW TO APPLY

Homes are selected throughout the year and are based on family circumstances, condition of the home and financial qualification.

Applications are processed year-round and are done so immediately upon request. Program deployment hinges on funding and volunteer availability.
